COPY OF STATE OF ILLINOIS WINEMAKING PREMISES LICENSE OR STATE OF ILLINOIS SPECIAL USE PERMIT LICENSE AND A CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE FOR SAID EVENT MUST ACCOMPANY SAID APPLICATION.

THE UNDERSIGNED, BEING FIRST DULY SWORN ON OATH DEPOSES AND SAYS:

- 1) The facts asserted in the foregoing application for a winery special use permit license are true, on information and belief.
- 2) I am duly authorized to and does sign this winery special use permit license application on behalf of said winery.
- 3) The corporation is duly organized and in good standing with, and eligible to do business in the State of Illinois.
- 4) The corporation is not indebted to said State of Illinois or the City of Decatur, Illinois.

5) Each officer, manager, director, agent and stockholder owning in aggregate more than 5% of the stock thereof has not been convicted of any offense or violation which would render such person ineligible to receive a license under the provisions of the Illinois Liquor Control Act of 1934, as amended, and is otherwise eligible under said provision to receive a license.

6) No law enforcing public official, Mayor or member of the City Council is interested in any way directly in the corporation or the business to be licensed.

7) I am qualified, as required by law and ordinance, for issuance of a liquor license.

IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTER 52 of the City Code of Decatur, Illinois:

SECTION 7. LICENSE FEE. Payment of a fee shall accompany the request for a temporary permit, in accordance with the following schedule:

1st permit / year	- \$100.00 per day
2nd permit / year	- \$150.00 per day
3rd permit / year	- \$200.00 per day
4th permit / year	- \$250.00 per day
5th permit / year	- \$250.00 per day
6th permit / year	- \$250.00 per day

In the event a license does not issue responsive to an application, the payment of the annual fee accompanying the same shall be refunded, otherwise, there shall be no rebate or prorated of a fee once paid.

Chapter 52, Section 8. B. WINERY SPECIAL USE PERMIT. The Local Liquor Control Commissioner may issue a winery special use permit for the sale of wine sold in the original containers which bear the vintner's label and which are corked, capped or otherwise securely sealed at the place of vinting at a market-type, special or festival event. Such license shall be issued to a winery licensed by the State of Illinois with a winemaking premises license or a special use permit license, and shall be for a period of not more than three days. The maximum number of winery special use permits issued to the same winery in one calendar year shall not exceed six (6) and not more than one winery special use permit shall be granted to any one winery in any one period of thirty (30) days.
